



# GRANT COUNTY FIRE DISTRICT #3 IS CREATING A HIRING LIST

## FIREFIGHTER/EMT

Grant County Fire District 3 is seeking applicants to create a hiring list for a Firefighter/EMT. We will maintain the list for six months. The position of Firefighter/EMT will provide day coverage to the Fire District on both weekdays and weekends while adhering to a 40-hour work-week. Salary is \$58,921.01 per current IAFF contract.

### Minimum Requirements

- Must have a high school diploma or G.E.D. certificate.
- Must be a legal resident of the United States.
- Must be at least 18 years of age or older.
- Must have a valid Washington State driver's license.
- Must meet knowledge, health, and physical qualifications established by the District.
- Must be and remain a non-tobacco user.
- Must pass a background investigation by the Fire District, or District's agent, and the Washington State Patrol.
- Must pass a pre-employment physical exam and drug test.

### Preferred Qualifications

- Have and maintain a current State of Washington Emergency Medical Technician Certificate or NREMT Certification

- NWCG certified (red card) Firefighter II
- I-100, I-200, and I-700 certifications
- IFSAC FF1, including Hazardous Materials Operations.
