65% Tuition Discount

Fire department and EMS personnel are eligible to receive a 65% tuition discount on most programs. They may also share a tuition discount of 50% with up to two (2) family members or friends.

On-Campus Student Scholarship

Fire department and EMS personnel's children may receive a minimum \$10,000 scholarship/grant toward a traditional, on-campus undergraduate degree (eligible programs, Montgomery campus).

Adult Children Tuition Discount

Adult children of fire department and EMS personnel may receive a 50% tuition discount on eligible programs.

Program Eligibility

- Applies to AK, ID, MT, NE, ND, SD, UT, WA, and WY
- 65% tuition discount available to first responders who begin classes by December 31, 2026. Those beginning January 1, 2027, or after will receive a 50% tuition discount.
- Must satisfy all admission requirements and maintain satisfactory academic progress.
- Must remain continuously enrolled, including summers, until completion of the degree (excluding traditional undergraduates).
- Must provide a letter from current employer on letterhead verifying employment, or for retirees, a letter from last department verifying retired status. Volunteer firefighters must provide a letter from their chief.
- Cannot be combined with any other institutional discount, award, grant, or scholarship but may still be used in conjunction with federal financial aid, including loans and grants, if eligible.
- Standard fees apply.
